



Are you at HIGH RISK for LUNG CANCER??

*Have a 20 yr or more smoking history?

*Smoke now or have quit in the last 15 years?

*Are between 50-80 years old?

Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommend annual lung cancer screening with a LOW DOSE COMPUTED TOPOGRAPGY (LDCT) detailed scan of lungs.

If cancer is detected, additional screening/testing may be recommended.
